#### **COMPETITORS:**

*PHRF spinnaker* (valid PHRF certificate required)

*PHRF non-spinnaker* (PHRF assigned by the scorer if not available from YRA)

*Ideal 18, Laser, and Mercury*

#### **START LOCATIONS:**

PHRF, one designs over 24': 1/2 to 1nm south of Captain Harbor Bell 1

Ideal 18, Laser, Mercury: 1/4 nm south of Newfoundland Reef

**START TIME:** 12:30 p.m. (1230 hrs) **FINISH TIME:** about 4:00 p.m. (1600 hrs)

**COURSE:** Weather dependent – Outside Captain Islands windward/leeward or best distance 7.5-15 miles. Ideal 18/Small boats inside Islands, as appropriate.

**TROPHIES:** First through third places for each class and first overall will be awarded at the OGYC post-race party.
